FAQ's Virtual event

How long is each live webinar?

Each live webinar will last for one hour. This may go over, if there is a lot of discussion with the audience, but generally should be one hour.

Time zones

We have tried to choose times for the webinars that will suit out global audience, though we understand this may be difficult due to time zones.

The on-demand videos and the resources pages will be available 24 hours a day.

I can't attend but can I still watch?

Yes you can. We shall be recording all the live webinars and they will be available to view up to 48 hours after the live viewing. The on-demand videos will be available throughout.

Any reading of presentations/case studies/papers can be recorded as 'Other learning activity' or 'private study'.


Bookings for the webinars
